1. **January 7, 2020: Alexander Dobbin's Gettysburg**
Join us at the historic Alexander Dobbin House (1776) for a special presentation on the early development of Gettysburg and the restoration of one of our town's most historic structures. Speakers: Timothy H. Smith and Jacqueline D. White.
2. **February 4, 2020: Three Lost Buildings**
Join us for a presentation exploring three important buildings in Gettysburg that no longer exist. We'll uncover their hidden history. Speakers: Jean Green, Jane Malone, and Lisa Shower.
3. **March 3, 2020: Dr. Henry Stewart: Renaissance Man of Gettysburg**
Learn about one of Gettysburg's most curious residents. Dr. Stewart was a jack of all trades: doctor, chemist, forensic pathologist, engineer, meteorologist, blacksmith, and architect. Learn about his fascinating life and legacy. Speaker: Bob Scappini.
4. **April 7, 2020: Abraham Lincoln as Commander-In-Chief**
Join well known Civil War author and historian Bradley M. Gottfried for a discussion about Lincoln's relationship with his generals with an emphasis on the Gettysburg Campaign.
5. **May 5, 2020: Gettysburg Hospital: 100 Years of Community Service**
Join us to explore the story of Gettysburg's Annie Warner Hospital. Through photographs and personal stories, our presenters trace the hospital's physical and technical growth over 100 years. Speakers: Dr. Ronald Krablin and Roseann McGlade
6. **June 2, 2020: An Evening with the Cyclorama Painting**
Join us for a special "after hours" program at the Gettysburg National Military Park Visitor Center. We'll explore the hidden civilian stories within one of America's most famous paintings. Speakers: Sue Boardman, Jody Wilson, and Mike Showlin.
7. **July 1-5, 2020: Farms of the Battlefield**
Join historian Timothy H. Smith and friends at various locations on the Gettysburg Battlefield for special, real-time anniversary programs on the farms and families of the battlefield.
8. **July, 2020 (date TBD): Confederate Field Hospital Bus Tour**
This special, behind-the-scenes bus tour will allow you to see some of Gettysburg's most obscure field hospital sites. A catered, historic barn breakfast will be included. Speakers: Timothy H. Smith and Andrew I. Dalton

9. **July 7, 2020: Elsie Singmaster: A Gettysburg Voice**
Join us to explore the life and legacy of Adams County's most famous author. Though Elsie's stories are fiction, we'll explore the history behind them and the real-life individuals who inspired her work. Speaker: Susan Colestock Hill.
10. **August 4, 2020: Exploring the Historic Flohr's Church Cemetery**
This year's annual cemetery walk will be at Flohr's church in Franklin Township. With graves dating to the 1790s, we'll uncover the stories of prominent western Adams County families. Speaker: Timothy H. Smith.
11. **September 1, 2020: A Walk Among Heroes: WWII Veterans in the Soldiers' National Cemetery**
From veterans of Pearl Harbor to Iwo Jima and Guadalcanal, Gettysburg's National Cemetery is the final resting place of so many World War Two heroes. Join us for a special program about these heroes. Speaker: Tara Wenzel.
12. **September (date TBD): ACHS Annual Meeting**
Join us inside the historic Scott barn in Freedom Township for lunch and a presentation. We'll also have an update on the ACHS Capital Campaign.
13. **October 6, 2020: Remembering Eisenhower in Gettysburg**
Join us for a special presentation commemorating Dwight D. Eisenhower's 130th birthday.
14. **November 10, 2020: What Did Your Ancestors Do for a Living? Business and Employment in Adams County, 1880-1930.**
We'll explore the types of businesses and occupations that existed in Adams County over a century ago. While you may have heard of some of them, many disappeared at the dawn of the 20th century. Speaker: Bonnie Richardson.
