INTRODUCTION

While working on the 1860 Gettysburg census index, I repeatedly thought about the fact that most of those people would be experiencing the Battle of Gettysburg three years hence. But since no one knows the name of every person - exactly - living in Gettysburg during the battle, I thought I'd go further than the 1860 census by comparing it with 1863 tax lists. This document is the result of my comparison work.

This document provides a comparison of the following sources:

- [1] The 1860 Census of Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania. An index of this census was completed by me and published in October 1995; copies of the index may be purchased from the Adams County Historical Society.
- [2] The 1863 Gettysburg Tax List, enumerated in October 1862.
- [3] The 1864 Gettysburg Tax List, enumerated in October 1863.
- [4] The 1863 enumeration of Gettysburg taxables, enumerated in November 1863.

This document is a listing of Gettysburg residents compiled from the four sources by comparing names and occupations. Only the 1860 census, source [1], and the 1863 taxables, source [4], provide occupations. This document lists all names in sources [2], [3] and [4], but it does not include all names in the 1860 census.

It must be emphasized and remembered that this document is only a guide; it does not provide proof that the information on any particular name line for the period 1860 through 1863 pertains to just that individual. For example, Jacob AUGHINBAUGH appears in the 1860 census as a cabinet maker, but as a clerk in the November 1863 taxables list. Maybe Jacob changed professions, or maybe there were two Jacobs. Further investigation into primary sources is needed. In a different type of example, the 1860 census tells us that a 54-year old harness maker was named Samuel KITZMILLER. Is this the same person as the saddler named Samuel KITZMILLER, Sr. in the 1863 taxables list? This document is intended only to assist the researcher -- further research will be necessary to establish fact.

This document gives information in eight columns, as follows:

NAME alphabetically by surname and given name(s).

NON-WHITE a mark in this column indicates that one or more of the sources had a notation of black, mulatto or colored for this name.
